ABOUT BOTA BOTA SPA-SUR-L'EAU



GETTING TO BOTA BOTA, SPA-SUR-L'EAU BY CAR

Due to its scenic location directly on the river, Bota Bota does not own land per se and subsequently does not have space for a parking lot in direct proximity of the boat.

You should expect to factor in parking time when planning your visit, with many options available nearby:



PARKING AT LA CITÉ MULTIMÉDIA

On 75 Queen street, between De la Commune West and Wellington, you will find paid parking at \$18 per day, or \$7 after 4pm and on weekends. When exiting the lot after parking, walk along De la Commune and turn left on the riverside promenade of the Old Port of Montreal. At your right you will see the wooden foot bridge which leads you to the Bota Bota garden

Poutine (/pu:'ti:n/; Quebec French: [putɕm]) is a dish originating from the Canadian province of Quebec consisting of French fries and cheese curds topped with a brown gravy. The dish emerged in the late 1950s in the Centre-du-Québec area and has long been associated with the cuisine of Quebec. For many years, it was negatively perceived and mocked and even used as a means of stigmatization against Quebec society. However, since the mid-2000s, poutine has been celebrated as a symbol of Québécois cultural pride, and its rise in prominence led to popularity outside the province, especially in central Canada and the northeast United States.
